READ—

The reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of Local Boards in the Bombay Presidency during the year 1914-15.

RESOLUTION.—During the year under review, the number of district local boards remained the same as in the preceding year, *viz.*, 26, while that of the táluka local boards decreased by one, being 215 against 216 last year. The decrease is due to the conversion of the Jamkhed táluka of the Ahmednagar district into a mahál from the 1st April 1914.

2. During the year the total area shown as administered by the local boards rose by 246·79 square miles to 123,141·01 square miles; the Central Division and Sind contributing 10 and 236·79 square miles respectively. The increase in the Central Division is due to the correction of the figure given last year in respect of the Ahmednagar district. The increase in Sind has not been explained satisfactorily. The Commissioner in Sind will be asked to report further on the subject. The population according to the last census figures was 18,062,041.

3. In the Northern Division the elective franchise was extended to the local boards in the Panch Maháls district with effect from the 14th April 1915. The Kaira Municipality, which had been suspended, had its franchise restored, and it again elected one member for the Táluka Local Board, Mehmabad. This involved a corresponding increase of one in the number of nominated members. In the Southern Division, the number of *ex-officio* members of the District Local Board, Belgaum, was one more than in the previous year, while the number of members of the District Local Board, Bijápur, on the other hand, was reduced by two, as the Bágalkot Municipality lost the privilege of returning a member on account of a decline in its population and as the number of nominated members was also reduced by one. In Sind, the district local board of Lárkána had two members more than last year, in consequence of the creation of the Mirokhan táluka. Arrangements have been made for extending the elective system to the Jamesabad, Umarkot, Khipro, Sanghar and Pithoro tálukas of the Thar and Párkar district. The only other areas where the elective franchise is not in force are the desert tálukas of the Thar and Párkar district and the tálukas of the Upper Sind Frontier. These areas are very backward and are not yet ripe for a change of system.

4. Triennial elections were held in the districts of Poona, Kaira, Bijápur, Lárkána and Thar and Párkar. They aroused only moderate interest, except in one táluka of the Poona district, where the number of candidates was more than double the number of seats contested.

5. The total number of meetings held during the year fell from 1,406 to 1,288, of which 91 were adjourned for want of a quorum. The rule regarding the holding of half-yearly meetings was complied with by all the district boards, but no less than 35 táluka local boards failed to hold the minimum number of four meetings prescribed in their case. In this respect the boards of the Northern Division were again the worst offenders, as many as nineteen out of a total of forty-one being defaulters. In the Central Division, in which last year there were no defaulting táluka boards, this year no less than 12 failed to hold the prescribed number of meetings. The Governor in Council regards this as most unsatisfactory, particularly in view of the orders passed in last year's review. The táluka local boards of Godhra and Kálol have failed for at least five

years in succession to carry out their duties in this respect. Should the reports for next year reveal no improvement in this matter, the Governor in Council will be compelled to consider whether these boards should not be superseded under section 67 of the Bombay Local Boards Act. The average attendance of non-officials at meetings was also unsatisfactory, the percentages for the Northern, Central and Southern Divisions and for Sind being 55·5, 51·5, 53·6 and 50·12 respectively as against 60, 55·1, 58·6 and 53·49 in the previous year.

6. The aggregate income of the boards rose by Rs. 83,000 to Rs. 82,11,000. The following statement compares the receipts under the principal heads of revenue with those of the preceding year:—

7. The decrease of Rs. 67,000 under "Land Revenue" is distributed over all the divisions, *viz.*, Northern (Rs. 17,000), Central (Rs. 2,000), Southern (Rs. 1,000) and Sind (Rs. 46,568). For the decrease in the Northern Division the Thána district is mainly responsible. The falling off (Rs. 15,629) in the latter district is due to the absence of the sum of Rs. 10,000, which was received last year as earnest money for the auction sales of lime stone in the Sálsette Táluka, and further to the non-realization of instalments which fell due during the year. The decrease in the Central Division is mainly due to smaller receipts in the Sholápur táluka from fees for sand and stone removed for building purposes. The decrease in the Southern Division is ascribed to the diminution of the public demand for sand and kankar. The decrease of Rs. 46,568 in Sind is due to a decrease in the proceeds of the rent of fisheries. The receipts under this head in Karáchi and Sukkur in 1913-14, amounting to Rs. 82,904 and Rs. 32,056 respectively, were incorrectly credited last year as "Miscellaneous" receipts under "Civil Works". They have been taken into account this year under Land Revenue, the total receipts in Sind under the latter head in 1913-14 amounting to Rs. 2,05,467 instead of Rs. 90,507, the figure shown in last year's report.

8. The large decrease of Rs. 2,30,000 under the head "Provincial rates" was distributed as follows:—the Northern Division, Rs. 1,46,000, the Southern Division Rs. 61,000, the Central Division Rs. 15,000 and Sind Rs. 8,000. In the Northern Division, Ahmedabad, Broach and Surat show large decreases, as there was no suspended land revenue to be recovered and as large amounts of arrears were collected in the previous year. The decrease in the Southern Division is also due to the latter cause. In Sind, Nawábsháh and Thar and Párkar show decreases of Rs. 10,000 and Rs. 14,000 respectively, due to suspensions of land revenue in cotton growing areas owing to the serious fall in the price of Sind cotton, which was brought about by the war. These decreases were partly balanced by an improvement in the receipts in other Sind districts owing to a good inundation. In the Central Division, the decrease is due to absence of arrears of local fund cess in the Ahmednagar, West Khándesh and Násik districts.

9. The very considerable increase of Rs. 4,57,000 under "Education" is chiefly due to the large grants made by Government towards school buildings

and equipment and towards the improvement of the pay of primary teachers. There were also increased receipts from fees and the sale of material of old school buildings.

10. The increases under "Interest", "Police" and "Medical", and the decrease under "Scientific and other minor departments", are small and call for no remarks. The decrease of Rs. 48,000 under "Miscellaneous" was chiefly in the Central (Rs. 33,000) and the Northern (Rs. 12,000) Divisions. The decrease in the former was due to the fact that abnormally large contributions were received during the previous year towards a technical school at Dhulia and a dispensary at Akalkuwa, and in the latter to the fluctuating character of the items coming under this head.

11. Under the head of "Civil Works" there was a decrease of Rs. 23,000

Civil Works. apart from the apparent decrease of Rs. 1,14,960 due to the mistake referred to in paragraph 7. Of this,

the Central and Southern Divisions were responsible for Rs. 4,000 each and Sind for Rs. 38,000, while in the Northern Division there was an increase of Rs. 23,000. The main sources of income under this head are (i) tolls on roads and ferries, and (ii) Government and popular contributions. Under the former sub-head there was, in the Northern Division, a decrease of Rs. 5,076, due to low bids for tolls in the Thána district and to the abolition of the toll at Shivcha Bund in the Sálsette taluka. In the Central Division the income from this source showed a large increase (Rs. 11,000) owing chiefly to the reimposition of tolls in the East Khándesh district, which has been sanctioned, as a special case, for a period of five years by Government Resolution, Financial Department, No. 1151, dated the 14th March 1914, to enable the board to repay the loan advanced by Government for the construction of certain roads. In the Southern Division there was a falling off in receipts on account of the abolition of tolls in the Kolába and Bijápur districts. The policy of abolishing tolls on provincial roads, which was initiated by Government in 1908, has been followed to a considerable extent by district local boards in respect of their own roads. As a further step in this direction, the district boards of Ahmedabad, Poona, Ahmednagar, Násik, Sátara, West Khándesh, Belgaum, Bijápur and Kánara have agreed to abolish the existing tolls on their roads in view of the annual payment to them by Government of sums fixed in perpetuity. These sums are calculated on the average for the five years ending 1913-14 of the receipts from tolls existing on the 31st March 1914 and are to be paid on condition that the whole amounts are spent exclusively on the construction and maintenance of roads.

Under "Contributions from Government" there was, in the Northern Division, an increase of Rs. 12,013, while under "Other Contributions" there was a decrease of Rs. 6,692, which is accounted for by the fact that in the preceding year a large contribution was received in the Ahmedabad district from the Wadia Bequest Fund towards the construction of a veterinary dispensary at Viramgám. In the Central Division the falling off in "Contributions" was comparatively small. In the Southern Division there was an increase under this head, which was due to the receipt in Belgaum, of a donation from the Wadia Trust Fund and a grant from Government for the veterinary dispensary at Chikodi.

The decrease in Sind under the head "Civil Works" is due to smaller receipts under tolls on ferries (Rs. 5,263); sale-proceeds of old buildings (Rs. 4,950); and contributions from Government (Rs. 18,833). The last instalment of the Syedpur Tanka ferry farm in the Karáchi district for the year 1912-1913 was recovered in 1913-1914. The sale of two local fund buildings—one in the Lárkána district and the other in Thar and Párkar in 1913-1914—yielded an income which did not recur in 1914-15. Similarly, grants were received from Government in 1913-14 for the construction of veterinary dispensaries at Matli, Dadu and Mirpur Khas.

12. The aggregate expenditure of the boards advanced by Rs. 6,03,000

Expenditure. to Rs. 84,42,000. The following statement shows the

distribution of expenditure under the several heads as compared with that in the preceding year :—

The more important items which call for remarks are commented on below.

13. *Administration*.—The decrease of Rs. 88,000 under this head is due to the remission, from this year, of the contributions levied from district local boards for services performed on their account by Government officers of the account, control and audit departments.

14. *Education*.—The expenditure under this head advanced considerably by Rs. 3,88,000 to Rs. 36,03,000. The increase was shared by all the divisions of the presidency, including Sind, and is attributable to the additional sums devoted to the improvement in the pay of teachers in local board schools, the opening of new local board schools, the entertainment of additional teachers for undermanned schools and grants for equipment and gymnasium.

15. *Scientific and other miscellaneous departments*.—The decrease of Rs. 15,000 under this head is distributed over all the divisions, viz., Northern (Rs. 3,000), Central (Rs. 2,000), Southern (Rs. 3,000) Divisions and Sind (Rs. 7,000). The decrease in the Northern Division is due to the abolition of the agricultural association under the Kaira District Local Board and the disbanding of the boring establishment which it employed. A smaller outlay on the equipment of veterinary dispensaries in Sátára and the absence of an agricultural exhibition in East Khándesh explain the decrease in the Central Division. Two new veterinary dispensaries were opened in the Southern Division.

16. *Civil Works*.—The expenditure under this head rose from Rs. 35,29,000 to Rs. 37,69,000, an increase of nearly Rs. 2½ lákhs. Of this increase, the Southern Division is responsible for more than a lákha and a quarter, the Northern Division for half a lákha, Sind for Rs. 39,000 and the Central Division for Rs. 9,000. The ratio of expenditure under this head for the whole presidency to the entire expenditure of the boards declined from 45 per cent. to 44·64 per cent. The following statement compares the charges under the various sub-heads with those of the previous year :—

17. *Communications.*—The major portion of the outlay on "Civil Works" was, as usual, devoted to the construction and repairs of roads and bridges. In the Northern Division the greater part of the expenditure was on repairs, and the increase was almost entirely under this head. Two road projects in the Surat district were delayed unavoidably. In the Central Division the expenditure on original works decreased, the decrease being marked in the West Khāndesh, East Khāndesh and Sholápur districts. In the Southern Division also the major portion of the increase was due to repairs. The construction of the Bādāmi-Mudkavi and Havin-Hippargi-Tálíkot roads in the Bijápur district and the Dabhol-Dápoli road in the Ratnágiri district was continued. The Commissioner is of opinion that the present financial resources of the boards are not sufficient for the efficient maintenance of all the local board roads. In Sind the increase in expenditure on original works was small and was counterbalanced by an almost equal decrease in expenditure on repairs. During the year a large number of school houses and dharmshalas, and several medical and veterinary dispensaries, were constructed.

18. *Water-supply.*—Except for the construction of a few tanks in the Surat district no works of importance were carried out in the Northern Division. The outlay on the improvement of water supply in the Central Division declined, chiefly in the Ahmednagar and Sholápur districts. The expenditure in the Southern Division also declined, mainly because several works for which budget provision was made in the Belgaum district could not be carried out.

19. *Arboriculture.*—Government note with satisfaction that progress was made in all the divisions except the Southern, where the Commissioner reports that the matter is receiving the attention of the boards.

20. The statement appended to this Resolution shows the opening and closing balances of the boards of the several districts of the presidency. All the divisions except the Southern show increased closing balances, while the aggregate of the closing balances of the whole presidency advanced by Rs. 32,000 to nearly Rs. 30 lākhs. The closing balances of all the boards, especially in Sind, are still much in excess of the prescribed minima, and, as last year, a considerable portion of these inflated balances belongs to educational funds. In the Northern Division, Panch Maháls, Broach and Thána have to a certain extent reduced their balances. The statement that in Broach many works could not be completed owing to the early setting in of the monsoon is not understood. In the Central Division, Sátára alone decreased its balance appreciably. The large increase in the balance of Sholápur is due partly to savings on funds allotted for educational purposes and partly to the payment of both the instalments of land revenue in March owing to a good season. The rise in other places is accounted for by the failure of the Educational and Public Works Departments to spend the moneys allotted to them. In the Southern Division the boards' balances reduced by nearly Rs. 1½ lākhs. The Sind balances were rather higher than in the previous year. The attention of the boards generally should be drawn to the remarks made by Government last year regarding the unnecessary accumulation of large balances.

21. In all the divisions of the presidency including Sind the non-official members in most districts are reported to have shown little interest in supervising works. In the Southern Division the system of visitors' books referred to last year was in force in the Kánara and Ratnágiri districts, and is being introduced in Kolába and Belgaum.

22. The history of the boards throughout the year has been uneventful, and there were no important changes in their methods of work. The administration appears on the whole to have been reasonably efficient, but it cannot be claimed for the boards that they have advanced far in the direction of local self-government.

The Governor in Council does not propose to discuss this question in the present resolution. He appointed last year a committee to enquire into the working of the existing boards and to suggest means by which they might be developed into efficient instruments of local self-government. The committee's report and the preliminary orders of Government on it have already been published for general information.

23. Copies of this Resolution should be submitted to the Secretary of State and the Government of India, and should be forwarded to all Commissioners and Collectors and to the other officers and departments concerned.
