GOVERNMENT OF BOMBAY.

GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

Resolution no. P.—52.

Bombay Castle, 2nd November 1926.

Read reports from the Commissioner in Sind and the Commissioners of Divisions on the administration of Local Boards in their respective charges during the year 1924-25.

**RESOLUTION.**—The year marks a further advance in the liberation of the local boards from official control. The number of District and Taluka Local Boards remained the same as in the preceding year, namely, 27 and 222, and except Upper Sind Frontier which had an official President, the Presidents of the other 26 District Local Boards were non-officials. Six District Local Boards which were re-constituted under the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, had elected non-official Presidents; while in the remaining twenty District Local Boards, which continued to be constituted on the old basis, non-official Presidents were nominated. The number of members of the District Local Boards increased from 502 to 574 in 1924-25.

Owing to the introduction of a reformed constitution under the Local Boards Act, 1923, the members of the Taluka Local Boards increased from 2,552 to 2,770. The number of non-official Presidents of Taluka Local Boards increased from 159 to 168, leaving 54 Boards still under official Presidents. In Sind all the 59 Taluka Local Boards had non-official Presidents and 42 out of 52 in the Southern Division.

2. *Elections.*—The reformed constitution for Local Boards under the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, came into operation during the year, the conspicuous feature being a three-fourth elective element and elected non-official Presidents and Vice-Presidents. A feature in the elections in the Central Division was the rivalry between the chief contending parties, *viz.*, the Brahmins and the non-Brahmins. In the Southern Division no fresh elections were held, though they were due in almost all the District Boards, as the date for reconstitution of the Boards fixed under section 34 of the Act fell during the year 1925-26. In the Northern Division elections were keenly contested, but there were indications that the voters were guided by personal feelings or influenced by political considerations rather than by the fitness of candidates.

3. *Meetings.*—The percentage of members attending each meeting of the District Local Board was 72·45 in the Northern Division, 64·8 in the Bombay Suburban Division, 63·5 in the Central Division, 66·6 in the Southern Division and 56·01 in Sind. The percentage for Taluka Local Boards was smaller ranging from 55·6 in the case of Sind to 67·5 in the Northern Division, where the attendance was better than anywhere else in the Presidency.

In addition to the actual number of meetings the provisions of section 41 of the Bombay Local Boards Act, 1923, were freely employed for the transaction of business by circular. A too frequent employment of the sanction given by this section is undesirable both because the intention of the Act is to limit its use to emergent cases only and because it is preferable that the disposal of business should be effected after discussion. The District Local Boards of Kanara, Kolaba and Karachi, and some Taluka Local Boards in Sind and the Northern and Central Divisions failed to hold the minimum

number of meetings prescribed by section 35 (1) of Act VI of 1923. Government expect the defaulting boards in future to conform to the requirements of the law.

Government note with satisfaction the appointment of Standing Committees for the disposal of current and ordinary business by the District Local Boards of Bijapur, Dharwar, Kanara, Ratnagiri, Ahmednagar, East Khandesh, West Khandesh, Poona and Nasik. Under section 36 (i) of Act VI of 1923 it is obligatory on the Boards to appoint Standing Committees and it is hoped that all Boards, which have not yet appointed such Committees, will do so.

4. *Income*.—The aggregate income of the Boards (excluding debit items) rose from 158 to 168 lakhs. The principal heads of revenue are:—

Land Revenue, which is derived from stone, sand and quarry receipts, and rent of fisheries; and receipts from this source amounted to Rs. 4,46,000.

Local Rates, which showed an increase of Rs. 9,15,000 over the previous year, amounted to Rs. 46 $\frac{3}{4}$  lakhs.

Interest amounted to Rs. 63,000, an increase of Rs. 23,000.

Police, which is derived from receipts under the Cattle Trespass Act, showed a considerable increase of Rs. 1,28,000, and amounted to Rs. 3,97,000.

Education, which is made up of school fees and Government and other contributions, amounted to Rs. 82,17,000, a decrease of Rs. 3,54,000.

Medical, which is derived from hospital and dispensary receipts, sale of medicines, endowments and Government and other contributions amounted to Rs. 1,97,000, an increase of Rs. 25,000.

Scientific and minor departments, the revenue from which is derived from botanical and other public garden receipts, veterinary receipts, receipts from public exhibitions and fairs and Government and other contributions, contributed Rs. 1,14,000, an increase of Rs. 9,000.

Civil Works, the revenue from which is obtained by tolls on ferries and roads, rent of buildings and lands, sale of buildings and other property, sale of stores and materials, staging bungalow fees, sale proceeds of trees, grass, etc., and Government and other contributions amounted to Rs. 24,09,000, an increase of Rs. 2,36,000.

Miscellaneous Income amounted to Rs. 2,52,000, an increase of Rs. 16,000.

5. *Land Revenue*.—The net decrease under this head of Rs. 6,500 is largely due to the big drop in the Northern, Southern and Bombay Suburban Divisions. In the Central Division and Sind there were increases of over Rs. 40,000.

6. *Local Rates*.—The reasons for the net increase of over Rs. 9 lakhs under this head call for no special mention, being due to the recovery of arrears, of suspended cess, and in some cases to an increase in the rate of levy.

7. *Police*.—The increase of over Rs. 1 $\frac{1}{4}$  lakhs under this head was shared by all Divisions and was due to the opening of new cattle pounds, increase in the rate of fines, etc.

8. *Education*.—Under this head receipts fell by Rs. 3,54,000. The Bombay Suburban, Central and Southern Divisions are responsible for smaller receipts than in the year preceding partly in consequence of the adjustment of Government grants received in excess in the previous year and also as a result of the reduction in Government contributions for primary education. In Sind and in the Northern Division the receipts were higher than those in the preceding year on account of additional grants received from Government during the year.

The other variations call for no special mention.

9. *Expenditure.*—The following statement shows the distribution of expenditure as compared with that in the previous year and amounted to Rs. 154 lakhs as against 152 lakhs in 1923-24:—

10. The increase under "Administration" is shared by all Divisions except the Southern Division, the main causes of the increase being new establishment, increased travelling allowance, increments and arrears of contribution to Government towards the pay of Taluka Local Board karkuns. The increase under the head "Education" was shared by all Divisions except Sind, the main cause of the increase being the payment of arrears of revised pay to primary school teachers. In Sind there was reduced expenditure under the head "Grants-in-Aid and Scholarships." The increase under the heading "Medical" calls for no special comment. The increase under "Scientific and other minor departments" was due to a variety of causes including the opening of new Veterinary Dispensaries, higher expenditure on medical stores, and in the Southern Division the entertainment of extra establishment owing to outbreak of cattle disease. The net increase in expenditure under the heading "Civil Works" which is, with the exception of Education, the most important head of expenditure, calls for no special comment, although there were considerable variations in the amounts spent under various sub-heads.

11. *Closing balances.*—The statement appended to this Resolution shows the opening and closing balances of the District Local Boards. The aggregate closing balances of all the boards amounted to Rs. 54,68,386 against Rs. 45,17,177 in the previous year. These closing balances are considerably in excess of the prescribed minima in all boards with the single exception of Bijapur. Various reasons are given to explain these large closing balances the principal being (i) a large part of them are made up of the funds held in trust for educational, medical and Veterinary Departments; and (ii) the collection during the year under report of the local fund cess suspended in the previous years, a circumstance not anticipated and therefore not budgeted for. However, the large closing balances indicate the necessity for closer budgeting and Government consider that effort on the part of Boards is required to make the estimated closing balances approximate more nearly to the prescribed minimum working balances.

12. *Works Committees.*—On the whole, these Committees appear to have worked fairly satisfactorily in those Districts where they were appointed during the year under report. There is, however, still room for improvement, which will only be possible as the members of the Committees realise their responsibilities and evince greater interest in their duties.

13. *Audit of Accounts.*—The accounts were fairly well maintained by the Boards. There were, however, the usual irregularities such as :—

- (1) Defective measurement books;
- (2) Rush of expenditure on works at the end of the financial year;
- (3) Want of completion certificates;
- (4) Deviation from sanctioned estimates;
- (5) Loss of local board tools.

As the result of the audit, the Vice-President of the District Local Board, Broach, one overseer and some contractors were prosecuted for defalcation of local board money. The Vice-President was acquitted and the prosecution against the others was withdrawn. One Local Fund Karkun at Ankleshwar in the Broach District was dismissed. In Kanara a sub-overseer and a clerk were warned for not taking actual measurements on the spot and for not keeping the accounts in order; and in Kolaba an overseer was removed and the pay of a maistry was withheld.

14. *Village Panchayats.*—In the Central Division no improvement was shown in the working of the Village Panchayats. Disinclination of the villagers to tax themselves and the consequent lack of funds to enable them to do any useful work are the main causes for their failure. In the Northern Division the number of village panchayats decreased from 58 in the preceding year to 54 in the year under report.

15. *General remarks.*—The working of the Boards was on the whole fairly satisfactory. The Chairman and members of the Boards have evinced greater interest and energy in their work. Generally the Boards were averse to additional taxation and are prone to depend upon Government for increased grants from provincial revenues for works and objects of purely local importance. This resulted in an inadequate attention to medical needs and neglect of roads, etc. As an instance of the former may be quoted the reduction by the Thar Parkar Board in the number of its vaccinators with results that were disastrous yet instructive. The Larkana Board refused on the ground of lack of funds to increase its usual grant to dispensaries in two small municipalities which serve a large area outside municipal limits. The principal question which the Boards have to face courageously and to solve is one of finance. Government have endeavoured to help the Boards, so far as the state of Provincial Funds permits. They are considering the recommendations of the Committee appointed to consider the question of financial aid to local boards to which a reference was made in the previous review. The Boards themselves have been given powers of levying taxes under Act IV of 1923. Taxation is always distasteful to the public and the members of the Board imposing new taxes have necessarily to face unpopularity. Government, however, hope that with the increased elected element in the Boards introduced by the new Local Boards Act, members will not shirk the task of putting the finances on a sound basis but will rise to the occasion. Local needs must be met by local taxation and Government deprecate the tendency of the Boards to place undue reliance on Government for financial support. Government are, however, fully alive to the necessity of improving the working of the Boards in various directions. The Committee to examine the question of the future of village panchayats, which was referred to in the previous review, has submitted its recommendations, which are under consideration. Two more Committees were appointed, one to consider the question of the transfer of provincial roads and buildings to District Local Boards for maintenance and another to consider and report on the question of the transfer of control of medical, vaccination and veterinary staffs to District Local Boards and the re-organisation of the Public Health Department. The labours of these Committees were not concluded till the close of the year under report.

who have not yet returned any member on the D.L.B.

During the year 1994-95 a small area of the D.L.B. has been taken over by the Mirpurkhas Municipality. As the population figures of this area are not available separately they have not been excluded.
